ITEM 4 - ISSUES RAISED BY THE PUBLIC

Concern was raised regarding the plague of rats in the village of Norton, with particular emphasis being placed on the Drainage Board dyke to the rear of the Antiques Shop and the estate between High Street and Back Lane Norton. Cllr. Franks reported that DMBC had now reversed its decision on the payment of treatment for rats and that private residences received a free treatment.

It was agreed that DMBC be advised of the rat problems in Norton and that an advert be placed in the Parish Magazine advising that the treatment for rats in residential properties was now free of charge.

Concern was raised regarding speeding tractors through the villages. Concern raised regarding litter in ditches and on public footpaths throughout the parish. The Chairman advised that arrangements were in hand to organise a litter pick throughout the parish.

There being no further business the Chairman thanked Members for their attendance and closed the meeting.
