We will always endeavour to provide you with a response. However some issues may require further discussion. In such cases, we will ensure we have your contact details and get in touch with you after the meeting.

Please sign in to the visitors' book and provide a contact number if you wish.

You are welcome to remain <u>as an observer</u> for the remainder of the meeting, or to leave after you have made your contribution.
