ITEM 1 - APOLOGIES for absence were received and accepted from Cllr. W. Grant.

ITEM 2 - FINANCIAL REPORT

The Clerk suggested that the Receipts and Payments Account for the year ending 31 March 2019, circulated with the agenda, could be dealt with at the Annual General Meeting.

ITEM 3 - CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chairman read out his annual report a copy of which is attached to the minutes.

ITEM 4 - <u>ISSUES RAISED</u> BY THE PUBLIC

The owners of Turpins Lodge Swan Syke Drive Norton enquired if the Parish Council had any comments on their current planning application. The Clerk circulated the application for comments. It was agreed that there were no objections and that the only comment would be to ask to Planning Authority to ensure that all new materials match existing in keeping with the Village Design Statement.

Concerns were raised about the following road safety issues:

- The poor public footpath around the Church, very narrow in places and that pushchairs and disability scooters had to have wheels on the highway to negotiate the bend.
- Speeding vehicles through the village of Campsall.
- Traffic calming measures were required on Bone Lane and Sutton Road Campsall.
- The poor condition of the highway at the junction of High Street, Sutton Road and No Road.
- The terrible condition of the footpath to Beech Road Campsall.
- The lack of grass cutting in Campsall Country Park, leaving large sections of meadow grass was unacceptable.

There being no further business the Chairman thanked members of the public for their attendance and comments and closed the meeting.
